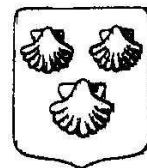

THE EASTER ANTHEMS

All 1 Christ our passover is / sacri · ficed / for us :
therefore / let us / keep the feast;

High voices 3 Christ being raised from the dead / dieth no / more :
