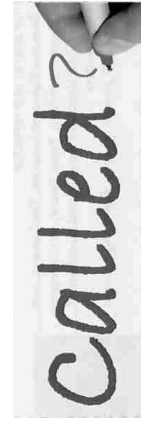
HOUSE GROUPS

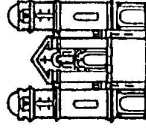
