SWINE FLU UPDATE – This week Bishop Tim has contacted all clergy in the Diocese to request that, following the reduction in infection levels, they return to the normal practice of distributing communion in two kinds, with the wine being given from a common cup. This advice follows a recent College of Bishops meeting, after which the Archbishops of Canterbury and York have issued updated guidance on hygiene and health precautions to the whole church. The Archbishops have agreed that each Bishop will determine the appropriate action for their own Diocese. Bishop Tim adds, “I do not envisage issuing further Diocesan-wide guidance about receiving communion unless there is a very serious need.”
