HARVEST THANKSGIVING Congratulations to the Flower Guild for beautiful decoration of the Church: the richness of the colours and textures warmed the cockles of our hearts on a dreary day. Harvest gifts of tinned goods and toiletries have been donated to the British Red Cross — whose staff was immensely grateful for them. Fresh fruit and vegetables were welcomed both by residents at Action Homeless and for its soup kitchen. Many thanks for all the contributions, including the baskets made up for specific recipients.

THE FUNDING PROGRAMME carried out over the summer months came to completion last Sunday as an added dimension to our Harvest Thanksgiving. Spearheading the campaign were **Angela Hefford** (Deputy Churchwarden) and **John Sharp** (Treasurer). Twenty-five **visitors** made personal contact with every regular worshipper – 181 households or individuals responded.

The total promised funding for each full year is now nearly £90,000 – an increase in giving amounting to very nearly £26,000 per annum.

This is a tremendous result, exceeding our ambitious target and a wonderfully generous expression of appreciation of this Church and trust in God's providence in difficult times. Profound thanks to everyone concerned.
