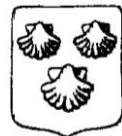
THE FUNDING PROGRAMME carried out over the summer months came to completion last Sunday as an added dimension to our Harvest Thanksgiving. Spearheading the campaign were **Angela Hefford** (Deputy Churchwarden) and **John Sharp** (Treasurer). Twenty-five **visitors** made personal contact with every regular worshipper – 181 households or individuals responded. The total promised funding for each full year is now nearly £90,000 – an increase in giving amounting to very nearly £26,000 per annum. This is a tremendous result, exceeding our ambitious target and a wonderfully generous expression of appreciation of this Church and trust in God's providence in difficult times. Profound thanks to everyone concerned.
