SATURDAY STOP-BY – a drop-in for homeless people – is a joint project between the Islamic Society of Britain and the Church of St James the Greater. It runs from 11.00 am until 2.00 pm providing the opportunity to socialise and have a hot lunch, provided by volunteers. Warm men's clothing and bedding / sleeping bags in good condition are always needed. AN ICON has been placed above the votive candle stand. The three persons of the Trinity are shown to be in a community of love for each other and for all of creation. **It is hoped that this icon may be a helpful focus for prayer and stillness at the centre of our church.**
