WE WISH the Jewish community **Happy Hanukkah** – the annual celebration of the rededication of the Temple in Jerusalem after it was recaptured from the Syrian Greeks by the Maccabee brothers in 165 BCE. This festival is brought to



our attention by the huge *menorah* – nine branched candle stand – erected on the corner of Victoria Park. One 'candle' is lit for each evening of the festival. The ninth candle is the 'shamash' (the servant candle) from which the other candles are lit. These lights are intended to be symbols of hope for rebuilding wherever in the world there has been destruction.
